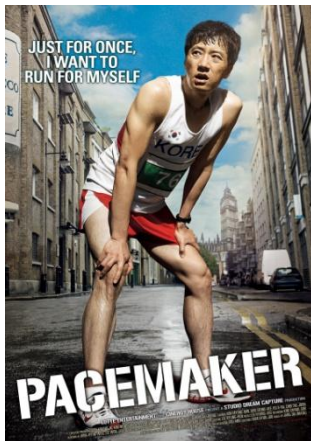

but for me, the race comes to an end after 30km

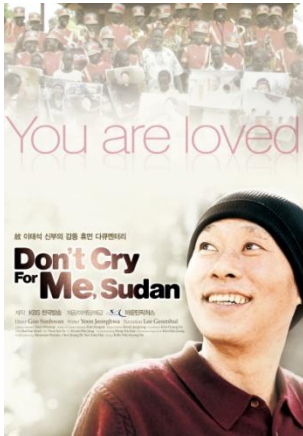
A national athlete who has no hope for medal or glory
